How to qualify for Nationals

You must have placed in the top four (4) at a state level to compete at nationals. This will be figured at the end of state finals. If for some reason one of the top four can't compete at Nationals for any reason the fifth (5th), sixth (6th), seventh (7th) and/or eighth (8th) place qualifying contestant may fill that spot as an alternate and attend the National High School Finals in that event.

How to sign up for Nationals

We will be signing up members after the conclusion of the awards ceremony. If you plan on attending Nationals you will need to get a packet to fill out which includes camping form, stall form, and the optional jackpot form. You will need to provide a check for these at the time of signups. There will be some forms emailed prior to State Finals which require both parents signature. I will send the forms early so that you can make sure that they are signed and notarized prior signing up for Nationals. If you are not planning on attending the NJHFR please let me know asap so that I can fill those vacant spots with an alternate.
