

WSHSRA MEETING via Zoom

4/1/2025

Called to order by President Tygh Campbell at 7:00pm

Treasurer – We received \$540 from Wild Rose Mercantile for our portion of shirt sales.

\$80,450 for raffle revenue so far. Jules is working on updating the budget and what will be covered with the funds we have received. This amount includes the extra ticket money that the seniors were required to sell, so she has to get everything lined out.

Jules states that our bank account is the lowest it has been in a really long time, and we need to plan ahead. Tygh asked Jules if she could get everything organized and then we will need to have another meeting in a couple weeks, date and time TBD.

Central Entry update –

Secretary – Tashia reports only 1 new member since the last meeting. No other news at this time. Tiffanie reports a total of 57 JH members now. She asked about ribbon roping and team roping, can they pick up a new partner for spring season or do they have to stay together. This was explained.

National Director – Golf carts will be the same rules as last year. No contestants can drive them, and you must be 21 years of age or older, and follow all of the rules. Ground rules for nationals will be sent to secretaries in the next few days. If there are any members that are interested in running for a national student officer position, Sue is willing to help out with that.

Scholarships/Online Auction – Diehl doesn't have any new information on the online auction but will get in touch with Ibbey in regards to this.

Ibbey is working on getting the logos and information from all of the donations so we can get this started soon. The discussion is to close the auction just before state finals so that we know how much is going to be earned for the scholarships. Tashia motioned/Diehl 2nd to close the online auction on Sunday of state final, after the last event. Motion passed

Spring Rodeos – We have a hay donation for Othello and State Finals. Tygh is working on getting them to donate for Coulee City as well.

Joel is not able to go to Yelm now, but Jackie and Tashia are working on this to find anyone that is available. Bobbi Tolman got a tractor donated for Othello. Jackie is working on setting up committees for each rodeo. Othello Ambulance is set and there is a fee. We also have several vendors coming to all of the rodeos. Sara Campbell is working with Jackie on the organization of getting volunteers.

Diehl made a motion/Jackie 2nd to use Brandon at Yelm for our ground guy. He has been working at that facility for over 10 years and know how the ground is and where everything is if we need help with anything. Motion passed

Sponsorship – Not on the call, but she did email Tygh with an update. Sponsorships are still coming in, but we are still needing JH saddle sponsors.

Raffle – The question was brought up about the kids that enter in the spring and if they are having to sell tickets. Discussion about timelines and how to make it work for Sunday of the 3rd spring rodeo (Basin City this year) – discussion of a good time for turning them in.

Diehl amended his motion to say that tickets must be received in the office at or before Basin City or they are not eligible to compete until they are turned in. Kelli 2nd. Motion passed

Student Board – Gemma reported that the kids are still working on planning events for spring season. She still needs help from parents for prom with planning and execution.

Senior related – Gemma is asking for permission to pay for the senior back numbers. She has several checks from parents for back numbers that are made out to WSHSRA, and she is needing to pay the invoice for these so that they are here before state finals.

State Finals schedule – Diehl would like to have scholarship day be Wednesday at state finals. We are going to run with last years schedule. Want to have awards list “approximately 1-2 hours after” the rodeo ends. Once points are confirmed and finalized.

Ryan – TR at nationals. Just wanted to make sure he understood correctly that if a header or heeler in the top 4 cannot make it nationals, it’s the next header/heeler up that would have the opportunity (5th place, 6th, place, etc.)

Diehl – Everything is going well. Cattle and Nina’s went up a little.
