

**WSHSRA SPECIAL BOARD MEETING via Zoom**  
**8/19/2025**

Called to order by President Tygh Campbell at 7:00pm

We started with going over our state run rodeo bids. Tygh mentioned that we need to keep our budget in mind.

It was asked if we should look more at the lowest bids to keep our budget in mind with our voting.

Tygh spoke on behalf of the judges bids. JR Wood put together a seminar for September 6<sup>th</sup> and all judges that have submitted bids will be attending Howard Larson, Sean Culver and Wayne Bronson(?) will be the instructors for this seminar. All of these judges have judged at least 1 of our rodeos in the last 2 years, so they are up on rules, and are willing to attend this seminar.

Marnie Gibbs was the only one to put in a bid for Goats so she is our goat contractor for Othello.

Aces Wild was selected for Rough Stock and Timed Event Stock

Justine Winn & Bettie Jo Plumlee were voted as our Yelm timers.

Zack Kellams was selected as our Yelm announcer.

Billy King & Joel Knapp were selected as our judges for Yelm.

Shamrock Rodeo was selected with a full bid as our contractor for goats, roughstock and chute doggers.

Stick Horse Cattle will have our timed event cattle.

Joel Knapp will have our Steer Wrestlers.

Table the average points until Longview. Discussion was open and a few members chimed in with dialog.

Tashia made a motion to table/Teresa Chrisman 2<sup>nd</sup>. Motion passed.

Discussion on raising entry fees Tashia made a motion/Andy 2<sup>nd</sup> to table this. Discussion again about financials. Scott Goodwin brought up that rough stock always loses money every gate and we need to figure out how to cover our costs. Tracy said that we need to look at this as a business instead of an association.

Motion PASSED.

State Finals points – keep it like we’ve done it in the past. JR made a motion/Tashia 2<sup>nd</sup>. Motion PASSED We need to make sure everyone understands that our HS has a SHOOT OUT ROUND, NOT short Go at State Finals.
